Some had two or three rooms that might serve as bedrooms, but the houses were remarkable alike in size and design. What archaeologists have not found is a palace-size residence in any Indus Valley city. That is very unusual for an ancient civilization. It would appear that if a city had a king or a leader that this leader lived like everyone else. The ancient Indus Valley houses were made of baked brick and were one or two floor high.

The Indus Valley Civilization was a cultural and political entity which flourished in the northern region of the Indian subcontinent between c. 7000 - c. 600 BCE. Its modern name derives from its location in the valley of the Indus River, but it is also commonly referred to as the Indus- Sarasvati Civilization (after the Sarasvati River mentioned in Vedic sources which flowed adjacent to the Indus) and the Harappan Civilization (after the ancient city of Harappa in the region, the first one ...
