### How To Use Old Legacy Lenses On Your Modern Nikon DSLR ...

With older Nikon lenses, typically turning the focus ring all the way to the right sets focus to infinity. With newer lenses, this is usually not the case; they'll focus a little bit beyond infinity, so you have to use autofocus or manual focus to set the lens to infinity.

The new Nikon Z mount takes all old Nikon lenses using the FTZ ("F to Z") adaptor. It works perfectly with AF-S, AF-I and AF-P lenses. But with AF-D and AF lenses you lose autofocus, plus (like with Nikon manual focus lenses such as AI, AI-S and AI-D and AE lenses), you have to open and close the aperture manually.
