How you can improve Fresno CA streets, buses, and bike ...  
The act's objectives were to: (1) provide productive employment for the unemployed; (2) hasten or initiate federal projects; and (3) provide humanitarian assistance to the indigent. GAO found that: (1) \$6 million in funds were awarded to 87 projects in Fresno County for public works projects and health care services; and (2) of the 279 people employed on 41 of the projects, at least 97 people had been previously unemployed.
